'Sea Festa Onomichi -- Sea Festival 2012 Onomichi/Fukuyama/Mihara --' is grandly and successfully held

'Sea Festa Onomichi -- Sea Festival 2012 Onomichi/Fukuyama/Mihara --' was held over the course of 16 days, from July 14-29 in the three cities of Onomichi, Fukuyama, and Mihara. It was originally scheduled to be held in 2011, but was delayed one year due to the East Japan earthquake and tsunami.

The opening ceremony was held on July 14 at the Shimanami Meeting Center (Onomichi). Yuko Hiratani, the mayor of Onomichi and head of the planning committee gave an opening speech, in which he stated that he would like to utilize the region's history and unique characteristics. During the ceremony, awards were also presented to the winners of the slogan and logo contests. The selected slogan was 'Dreaming for the future of the Seto Inland Sea'.

On July 18, the Imperial Prince and Princess Akishino also paid a visit, and a welcoming ceremony was held at the Shimanami Meeting Center. Imperial Prince Akishino-no-miya Fumihito stated, "This region is located in the Seto Inland Sea, which was our nation's first national park. It has historical cultural heritage sites, beautiful inland ocean scenery such as the Shimanami Kaido, shipbuilding and fishing industries, and plays a role as a logistics hub. Holding a Sea Festa with the theme of the ocean here holds a significant meaning. It is our duty to properly recognize the importance of the sea and to transmit that message to future generations." A message from Prime Minister Yoshihiko Noda was also read, after which the ceremony concluded with an awards presentation to distinguished maritime industry personnel.

Sea Festa Onomichi, during which many events were held, concluded on July 29. The total visitor count was 1,055,000. During the closing ceremony, Mayor Hiratani stated, "I'm happy that the three cities were able to work together to attract more than one million visitors. As Sea Festa continues on into next year and the year after that, I look forward to creating a city that is thankful for the boon the sea has provided us." Sea Festa will be held in five cities in Akita prefecture in 2013, namely Oga, Akita, Katagami, Mitane, and Ogata, so the Sea Festa flag was passed on from Mayor Hiratani to the mayor of Oga City, Yukio Watabe.
