

How to separate and dispose of garbage

- Please sort your garbage accurately.
- Garbage in violation of the rules shall not be collected.
- Please take out your garbage at your local designated area by 8:30 a.m.

Concrete examples of how to separate garbage correctly

<p>Burnable Garbage</p> <p>Dispose of burnable garbage in a clear or translucent bag.</p> <p>Garbage day Every week, on</p>	<p>Wood and leaves (50 cm or less) (Bring to the Clean Center or send a request to licensed contractors in the case of large quantities)</p> <p>Shellfish shells</p> <p>Shoes</p> <p>Mayonnaise containers Ketchup containers Mustard tubes Wasabi tubes Etc.</p> <p>Plastic wrap</p> <p>Disposable body warmers</p> <p>Kitchen scraps (Drain all liquids completely!)</p> <p>Paper diapers (Flush excretions)</p> <p>Oil containers</p> <p>Poultice (Disposable, adhesive, medicated heating pads)</p> <p>Coolants</p>	<p>Plastic Bottles (PET)</p> <p>Dispose of plastic bottles (PET) in a clear bag.</p> <p>Garbage day Every month, on</p> <p>Wash the inside, and remove caps and labels.</p>
<p>Plastics</p> <p>Dispose of plastics in a clear bag.</p> <p>Garbage day Every week, on</p>	<p>Some plastics are recyclable. Dispose of plastics after washing.</p> <p>Instant noodle containers</p> <p>Egg packs</p> <p>Medicine containers</p> <p>Candy bags</p> <p>Food trays (Take them to a supermarket near you.)</p> <p>TOFU containers</p> <p>Detergent containers</p> <p>Shampoo containers, including refill packs</p> <p>Styrofoam</p> <p>Plastic shopping bags</p>	<p>Plastic Bottles (PET)</p> <p>Dispose of plastic bottles (PET) in a clear bag.</p> <p>Garbage day Every month, on</p> <p>Wash the inside, and remove caps and labels.</p>
<p>Non-burnable Garbage</p> <p>Dispose of non-burnable garbage in a clear bag.</p> <p>Garbage day Every month, on</p>	<p>Put in a separate clear bag...</p> <p>Toys</p> <p>Fans</p> <p>Boots</p> <p>Gas stoves</p> <p>Stoves (Be sure to empty kerosene and remove batteries.)</p> <p>Plastic buckets</p> <p>Toothbrushes</p> <p>Plastic cover (from the dry cleaner)</p> <p>Razors (Wrap the blade in paper.)</p> <p>Futons Blankets Curtains (Tie them lengthwise and crosswise.)</p>	<p>Put in a separate clear bag...</p> <p>Video tapes</p> <p>Cassette tapes</p> <p>Lighters</p> <p>Dry batteries</p> <p>Clinical thermometers</p>
<p>Landfill Garbage</p> <p>Contact the Clean Center to apply for collection.</p> <p>Garbage day Every month, on</p>	<p>Dishes Ashes Put in PP sandbags before disposal.</p> <p>For articles made of glass, put in a cardboard box and write "waremono" (fragile) on the box.</p> <p>Fluorescent lights Put into their original boxes or tubes. Fluorescent lights are recyclable; please do not break them.</p>	<p>Bulky Garbage</p> <p>For TVs, refrigerators, washing machines and air conditioners, ask an electrical appliance retailer.</p> <p>There is a charge and it is necessary to apply for the disposal of bulky garbage. Take out the garbage on the day specified by Onomichi City. You cannot dispose of bulky garbage at your designated area. You can also bring such garbage directly to the Clean Center or apply for collection.</p> <p>As a rule, all objects larger than 50cm are considered "bulky garbage". For details, contact the Clean Center.</p> <p>Dressers</p> <p>Sofas</p> <p>Carpets</p> <p>Desks</p> <p>Beds</p> <p>Bicycles</p>
<p>Recyclables</p> <p>Put recyclables in their designated containers.</p> <p>Garbage day Every month, on</p>	<p>Cardboard</p> <p>Newspapers</p> <p>Magazines</p> <p>Clothes (Wool and leather articles, as well as underwear and socks are "burnable garbage".)</p> <p>Paper cartons (Wash, dry and cut open.)</p> <p>Paper boxes, wrapping paper, etc. (Everything larger than a postcard.)</p> <p>Reusable bottles (Sake and beer bottles)</p> <p>Recyclable bottles (Brown, clear, and others)</p> <p>Separate bottles in two categories:</p>	<p>Used cooking oil Pour vegetable oils in a clear plastic bottle, screw the cap on tightly and put the bottle in the designated, blue containers.</p> <p>Portable gas cylinders Spray cans (Empty the contents and puncture the can)</p> <p>Steel cans</p> <p>Aluminum cans</p>

- To dispose of a business's garbage, or large amounts of garbage (when moving, pruning plants, earth and sand, rubble and tiles, etc.), bring them to the Clean Center or apply for collection through a licensed contractor. Onomichi City will not collect this garbage.
- Ask the relevant retailers for the disposal of tires, car batteries, motorcycles, propane gas cylinders, fire extinguishers and farm tools. Onomichi City will not collect them.
- You can bring garbage to the Clean Center between 8:30 and 12:00, and between 13:00 and 16:00, except on weekends, holidays, and year end, New Year holidays. However, you can bring garbage to the Clean Center on the 4th Sunday of every month, from 8:30 to 12:00.
